Unless otherwise stated all rates stated in this guide are charge-out rates excluding GST, profit and allowance for overheads.





RECOMMENDED INSURANCES

Workers Compensation Insurance

This policy is a requirement of Workcover WA for anyone engaging employees within the business. The main purpose of this insurance is to cover injuries to any employees of the business.

Construction Insurance

This policy contains two sections – Section 1 covers loss or damage to the actual works being carried out and section 2 covers loss or damage to third party property or injuries to third parties.

Public/Products Liability

A standalone public liability policy might be preferred for Landscape Suppliers and Landscape Designers and it covers loss or damage to third party property or injuries to third parties.

Professional Indemnity Insurance

This policy provides cover for financial loss to third parties as a result of a breach of your professional duty by reason of any negligent act, error or omission.

Business Package

This policy provides cover for your business premises (ie. Building and/or Contents) for insured events such as Fire, Storm, Earthquake and can also extend to include Theft, Money, Glass, Tax Audit and Tools of Trade away from the business premises.

Motor Insurance and trailer insurance are of course crucial policies as in most cases without transport you cannot attend your projects or deliver your products.

Additional Classes of Insurance that can be considered

There are some additional classes of insurance, not currently purchased, that you may also wish to consider. We have outlined some of these additional classes below.

- **Cyber Liability**: This policy provides cover for electronic exposures such as data breaches including loss of personal and corporate data and can be extended to include Extortion, Hacker Damage and Business Interruption.
- Management Liability Insurance: This type of policy is designed for privately owned companies and incorporates Directors & Officers Liability, Employment Practices Liability, Fidelity Guarantee and Trustees Liability cover. This policy can also extend to include Tax Audit cover.
- **Corporate Travel Insurance**: This type of policy provides cover for Directors, Executives and Employees of the Insured (including accompanying family members) whilst on authorised business travel on behalf of your company.
- Marine / Inland Transit: This policy provides cover for assets damages whilst in transit anywhere in Australia.

WORKCOVER

All employees must be covered by worker's compensation insurance. You can shop around for the best premiums via your broker however, with this type of insurance, their hands are tied as rates for insurance are gazetted.

LEAVE

There are no provisions for long-service leave under the Gardening and Landscaping Services Award but this is legislated in Western Australia. More information can be found here:

OTHER

Other employee information and communication to consider:

- You may need to ask your employees to complete a vehicle use policy form
 which outlines your requirements for those employees who will be driving
 company vehicles. Information may include the requirement for a valid
 license depending on the class of vehicle they will be driving, your policy
 on alcohol being consumed outside or within the vehicle, unauthorised
 passengers, influence of drugs etc.
- A social media policy
- · A phone use at work policy
- A uniform policy
- Your code-of-conduct

Under the Gardening and Landscaping Services Award 2020, an annual shutdown is allowed and employers can ask staff to take the time off as annual leave. There are requirements around this including at least one month's notice in writing of the dates.

 Make yourself familiar with the Award. There is some flexibility allowed within certain provisions but careful calculations must be made to ensure that the employee is not worse off under negotiated changes.

The estimate of the cost includes the cost of supplying any materials needed for the work. An estimate is required if, after making all reasonable enquiries, the builder cannot give a definite amount for the item at the time the contract is entered into.





HOW TO TAKE A SOIL SAMPLE

Correct soil sampling is critical to ensure accurate analysis and interpretation. Precise nutrien management can only occur with a quality representative sample.

IMPORTANT CONSIDERATIONS

- Soil samples can be taken any time of the year, however avoid extremely wet conditions.
- For maintenance programs sampling should occur at the same time each year in each
- Regular tests build a better profile of data
- Sample different soil types separately
- Sample varying topography (hills and flats) separately
- Avoid poorly drained areas

SAMPLING

A soil probe or augur is the best tool for taking samples, but a spade or shovel will also work well. The technique for using a spade is to dig a hole to the sampling depth. Cut a 25mm this slice of soil from the face of the hole to obtain a strip of soil about 25mm wide from top to bottom.

- Each soil sample should be a composite consisting of the soil from cores (or slices) taker randomly at several places across the sampling area.
 - The purpose of this sampling procedure is to minimise the effects of any local no -uniformity in the soil.
- 2. Cores or slices of soil, from about 10-20 locations over the area, should be taken for each soil sample.
- The soil cores should be well mixed in a clean plastic bag or bucket. Metal containers, i.e. galvanised metal will contaminate the sample.
- Avoid sending wet samples to your chosen laboratory as it significantly increases
 processing time and adds weight to your postage. Place about 200-300gms of the
 composite sample in the plastic bag.

TIP

- 1 Ensure a representative sample is obtained
- 2 Ensure all your equipment is cleaned in before each sample is taken
- 3. Remove debris and plant material from the soil surface
- 4. Take the required number or cores utilising a transect or zigzag sampling plan
- 5 Pool your cores in a clean plastic bucket, breaking the soil into small crumbs
- 6 Mix the sample thoroughly in the bucket
- Place your representative sample into soil test bags from an appropriate testin laboratory and fill to the required line.
- 8. If using a shovel ensure the sample is consistent down to the required depth (e.g. take slice down the side not a V sample)
